CINCINNATI -- Adults and children were digging in the dirt in Clermont County today.

A grant from PNC Bank, donations from Marvin's Organic Gardens in Lebanon, plus lots of volunteers are helping create this new garden.

The garden will be at Child Focus along Cincinnati-Batavia Pike and will include paths, a patio and plants designed to attract birds and butterflies.

Child Focus is an agency with early childhood programs and mental health services.

Volunteers said this will be more than just a single day of learning for the kids.

"They're going to be here every day and they're going to be able to watch these little plants grow up through the soil and understand that they helped contribute to that," said Connie O'Conner, of the Cincinnati Nature Center. "We bring a lot of kids out to the Nature Center and that's really great for them, but they don't get to go out there every day."
